PRINCESS PHOENIX is Brighton-based alt Indie Pop act Daisy Freeman and Tom Callaghan.

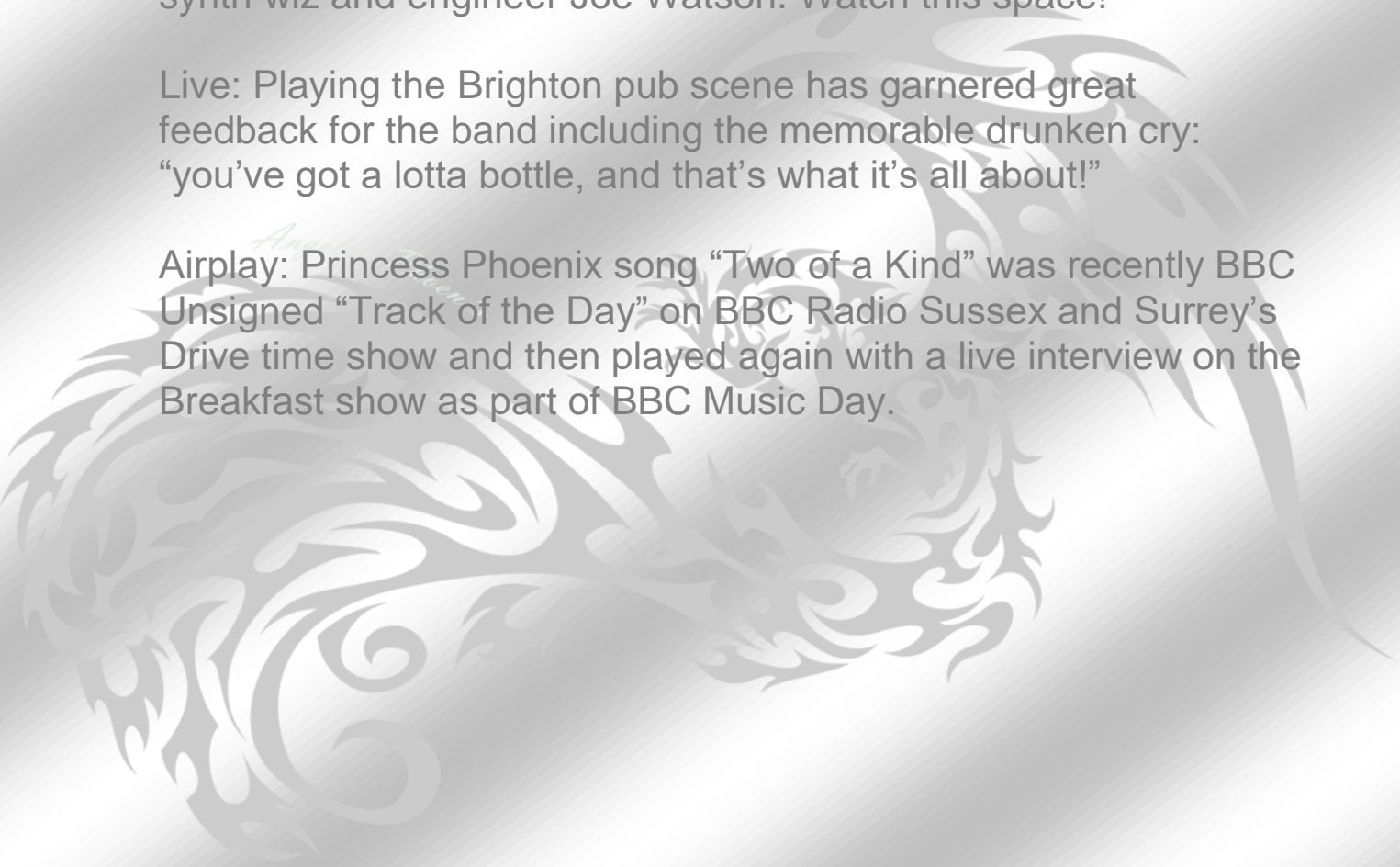
